Now, the adventures continue—follow Dan Kincaid's memorable character Kade Holley through this series of books that relates Holley's experiences as a Forest Ranger across the US. Explore the remote Blister Swamps of the Monongahela National Forest, track down poachers,

and prevent forest fires. Read along as Kade helps develop urban forestry and conservation efforts, and learn about the experimental forests of the south.

Many of the stories take place throughout the National Forests of Appalachia. Kincaid pulls inspiration from his own experiences as a forest Ranger and educator. He shares his wealth of knowledge through Kade Holley in an entertaining yet informative way. While there are moments of suspense and frequent danger, there is an underlying love of nature, friends, and family that will keep you coming back to read more.
